### What is a

**Rooming House?** 



• Max 5 rooms to one bathroom, shared or no kitchen

- For profit, and non-profit
- Licensed and unlicensed
- \$350.00 to \$650.00/month
- Pay extra for cable, air conditioning...
- "Bottom rung" of housing ladder




## Who Lives in a Rooming House?

- Majority are men
- 63% are on OW or ODSP (almost 75% earn less than
- \$15 000/year)
- 86% rely on food banks or drop-in meals
- 35.5% report being in fair or poor health
- 40% have no family doctor
- 55% have lived in room for less than 1 year
- 56% have problems with addiction
- 60% reported having health conditions, with 68% of these being mental health conditions, 19% of theses having 3 or more mental/physical condition

  » Profile of Rooming House Residents CMHC - 2006






