

Key Learning Outcome

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Ontario Public Health Standards

'Infectious Diseases Program Standards'

Two societal outcomes are - to decrease the rate of adolescent pregnancies & to reduce transmission and incidence rates of Sexually Transmitted Infections(STIs) and Blood borne infections(BBIs)

Cost Benefits to the community:

- Direct cost of teen pregnancy is \$2000.00 and it costs \$12,000.00/year to support mother and child
- The economic costs for someone with AIDS can be \$800,000.00




















Benefits of Abstinence









"Nurse is in" sign at the back entrance

 - Daytime, evening, weekend?
- Services provided
 - One stop service for all sexual health testing/issues
 - Provider attitudes; non-judgemental, welcoming
 - Having supportive policies
