Competencies: The Value Proposition



- Competencies:
 - Define the scope and depth of practice
 - Establish criteria for acceptable nursing practice and safe ethical care
 - Support ongoing development
 - Promote community health nursing as a specialty
 - Provide foundation for certification
 - Inspire excellence

Competencies: The Value Proposition



- Provide specific guidance to the knowledge, skill, judgment and attributes required to practice safely and ethically
- ↑ specificity from the perspective of expectations
- Tangible and behavioural

1. Elements of Home Health Nursing

These elements and associated competencies focus on the nursing activities, functions, goals and outcomes that are central to home health nursing practice.

Elements of Home Health Nursing



- Assessment, Monitoring, and Clinical Decision Making
- Care Planning and Care Coordination
- Health Maintenance, Restoration and Palliation
- Communication
- Relationsihps
- Access and Equity
- Building Capacity



2. Foundations of Home Health Nursing

These competencies focus on the core knowledge and primary health care philosophy that is central to home health nursing practice.

Foundations of Home Health Nursing



- Health Promotion
- Illness Prevention and Health Protection



3. Quality and Professional Responsibility

These competencies focus on practice activities and/or strategies by which the home health nurse promotes quality of care and demonstrates professional responsibility. Quality and Professional Responsibility
