# Comprehensive PHN Education Program



- Component One:
  - Fraser Health Education for all Employees
    - Orientation for New Employee, WHIMIS, etc
- Component Two:
  - PHN Specific Education
    - PHN Orientation Program, In-Services
- Component Three:
  - PHN Professional Development Education
    - Conferences, workshops, education opportunities

# PHN Professional Development Education



- CNE team wanted to engage experienced PHNs in a professional development activity
- Developed a CNA CHN Certification
   Program Proposal
  - Retention strategy
  - Leadership and succession planning
  - Competency and capacity building

# CHN CNA Certification Pilot Project Components



- Marketing and Promotion
  - Recruitment of participants
  - Registration for exam
- Facilitated Study Groups
  - Registration for study groups
  - Resources materials
  - Coordination and facilitation
- Celebration and Evaluation

## FH CHN CNA Certification Pilot Project Funding Costs



- Sponsorship for exam fee
- Purchase of resource material texts
- 50% of time to attend study groups and to write exam
- 100% of time to attend the Evaluation and Celebration Event
- Excellence in Community Health Nursing vests




## Participants in Project:

- 27 participants
- 93% attended weekly study groups regularly
- 89% attended the Celebration and evaluation event
- 100% completed evaluation survey
- Online follow-up survey



#### Years in PH Nursing




#### **Participants**

## **Capacity Building**


 96% reported that it was very valuable or valuable in impacting the way they think about their practice


