Health Promotion Definition:

"The process of enabling people to increase control over the determinants of health and thereby improve their health" (World Health Organization, 1986)



Intervention Framework

Strategies to address the health determinants:

- Strengthening Community Action
- Build Healthy Public Policy
- Create Supportive Environments
- Develop Personal Skills
- Reorient Health Services

A community development approach to health promotion offers the opportunity for all school community stakeholders to participate in activities to improve the health of the school community



Why this approach?

- Provides a comprehensive picture of the community through assessment and consultation
- Collaboration and partnership development
- Role of the nurse as a facilitator
- Community networks
- Provides a common language with partners
- Builds capacity of community
- Based on CCHN Standards of Practice



Community Development Model

- 1. Community Assessment and Key Findings
- 2. Community Consultation
- 3. Consensus Building / Setting Priorities
- 4. Forming the Group
- 5. Networking and Building on Community Resources
- 6. Action Plan and Implementation
- 7. Critical Reflection and Evaluation



Community Assessment

- Define and describe the community
- Create a comprehensive picture
- Tools
 - Information Collection Tool
 - Key Findings
 - School and Community Profile
 - Demographics



Community Consultation

- Consult with the community to understand the assets and issues
- Validate assessment data
- Identification of leaders, champions and stakeholders
- Tools
 - Interview guidelines for individuals and groups
 - Contact list
 - Summary report of consultations



Forming a Group

- Community members who share a common vision
- Sense of readiness to collaborate
- Tools
 - Community Collaboration Progress
 - Terms of Reference
 - Vision
 - Assess effectiveness of collaboration and group processes



Build Consensus with Community on Priority Issues

- Consensus building to select and issue and strategy
- Everyone supports the decision
- Tools
 - Checklist for consensus building
 - ICA (Institute of Cultural Affairs) group consensus workshop methods
 - Ground rules/conversation guidelines
 - Conflict resolution



Networking and Building Community Resources

- Who else and what else do we need to move this forward?
- Tools
 - Network mapping guide
 - Resource inventory captured in the action plan



Action Plan and Implementation

- Creates a long term framework for decision making and action
- Identifies objectives and actions that can be measured over time
- Tools
 - School Community Health Action Plan
 - Group Membership List



Evaluation and Critical Reflection

Integral to all the processes


- It's about the process as well as the outcome
