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

National Collaborating Centres for Public Health (NCCPH)


- Six National Collaborating Centres across Canada
- established by the Public Health Agency of Canada to renew and strengthen public health
- overall mission is to translate existing and new evidence into knowledge that is meaningful, accessible and relevant to public health decision-makers
- we draw on regional, national and international expertise
- we collaborate with the provinces and territories, researchers and nongovernment organizations

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Results: Networks in general

Results: Ways in which DialoguePH can add value

- Create opportunities to link with other public health professionals working in a similar content area 91% (n=87)
- Provide access to individuals with expertise in evidence informed decision making (EIDM) 87% (n=84)

Results: Ways in which DialoguePH can add value

- Support information sharing 83% (n=80)
- Create opportunities for skill development specifically related to the steps of evidence-informed decisionmaking 68% (n=65)
- Create opportunities to connect with those involved in program development 66% (n=64)

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Results: Topics for discussion forums


- Where to find evidence related to a public health issue in "5 minutes" (78%, n= 76)
- How to integrate evidence into policy or program decisions (78%, n=76%)

Results: Topics for discussion forums cont'd

- Methods and tools to support making evidenceinformed decisions (77%, n=75)
- How to disseminate information to relevant audiences (68%, n=66)
- Evaluation (57%, n=55)

Value, participation and consent

- 93% (n=89) indicated DialoguePH could support them in using evidence in their work
- 92% (n=86) believe that DialoguePH will provide them with something to which they do not currently have access



Value, participation and consent cont'd

- 98% (n=92) will participate once interactive
- 91% (n=88) gave consent to be in shared DialoguePH database



Language: Let's be clear... Methods and Tools

- standardized procedures or products that facilitate access to, and/or use of, information for decision-making
- for example, methods and tools could be
- regular and systematic approaches (e.g., processes for critically appraising the literature, processes for conducting systematic reviews)
- sets of organized steps or rules (e.g., steps to forming partnerships or collaborations)
- instruments or guidelines (e.g., surveys/questionnaires)



Language: Let's be clear... Knowledge Translation

Knowledge translation is a dynamic and iterative process that includes synthesis, dissemination, exchange and ethically sound application of knowledge to improve the health of Canadians, provide more effective health services and products and strengthen the health care system. (CIHR)
