



ply Model to Education Example from Marie Dietrich urer (2015)

- ucation & Community/Public Health Example:
- Students prepare and serve nutritious meal to 1. The Client (Individua street involved youth once a week followed by educational or recreational activity
- Obtain feedback on activities and ask for suggestions
- Received ethical approval for project
- Obtained funding originally from university, subsequently found corporate sponsor for another three years

me Care Example:

Nurse assigned to client with palliative care needs. Nurse does not have training n palliative care.

Nurse informs manager on call of lack of expertise. Manager guided nurse in providing safe care.

Manager met with Director to discuss why nurse was inappropriately assigned.
