- \* ARNBC has 2 Communities of Practice.



#### Contrast Media and Breast Milk

Patient Information

Current evidence suggests that mothers can continue to breastfeed or give breast milk after exposure to the following radiocontrast (contrast media agents):

Omnipaque® Visipaque®.

 Less than 0.5% of the mother's dose reaches the infant through the breast milk.

#### Risk of Side Effects to the Infant:

Side effects are not likely

If you would prefer your infant to have no exposure to the contrast:

- · Express your milk prior to the test so you can continue giving your breast milk.
- Pump & discard your breast

### Domperidone

Patient Information

#### Worried about a low milk supply?

Some mothers worry about whether they are making enough milk for their baby. If you have tried everything, a drug called domparidona may help. However, it is important. to first get support from your care team and try other ways to increase your milk supply

#### Your care team

Talk to a doctor, nurse practitioner, midwife, breastfeeding counsellor, public health nurse, or lectation consultant. They will help you with your breattheating goals.

#### Natural ways to increase your milk supply

Make ture your baby it:

- · latched deeply and comfortably
- . feeding often (at least 8 to (2 times per day)
- · rearring from both breasts and sucking long enough to stimulate your supply

- + breast compression and massage while breastfeeding
- + hand expression or using a breast pump after breamfeeding (ask your care team about breast

Things to avoid.

- · artificial nipples and spothers
- · formula (uniosa recommended by your care teams

#### Domperidone

Demperidene is a medication used to help people with stomach problems such as reflux and heartfrum. It sito felps your body produce more of a hormone called protectivi, which heigh your body make bewast milk

Ask someone on your care twim if this drug is right for you. Domportione works best when used with the recoral methods. You should see an improvement within 5 days.

#### Stopping domperidone

Do NOT just stop taking domparidone. Talk to your care team fine.

#### How to stop taking domperidone

If you took 3 pills a day, take only 2 pills a day for 2 to 3 days. If your thick supply is still good. take 1 pill for the next 2 to 3 days. If you notice that your melk supply starts to slow again. go back to the number of pills. that made a good milk volume.

#### Safe use of domperidone

Demperations is generally safe for healthy mothers who do not have a family history of heart

Inform your doctor if there is any hocory of heart rhythor problems in your family.
